DESCRIPTION

The City of Charlotte's Comprehensive Neighborhood Improvement Program (CNIP) makes strategic investments larger, multi-neighborhood geographies to more comprehensively address a broad array of community needs. This complete approach to placemaking focuses on community connectivity, through streetscape improvements, pedestrian and bicycle safety, and neighborhood beautification.

The Central/Albemarle/Shamrock CNIP area includes neighborhoods to the east of Uptown, from Eastway Drive at The Plaza, to Central Avenue, and out along Albemarle Road. Artist Carrie Gault is working with ASC, The City of Charlotte, STV Inc., and Alta Planning and Design to create public artworks for the Shamrock Drive Street Improvements and Central/Kilborne Pedestrian Improvements. The artist is currently in the planning phase for each section and working with consultants and the communities to identify potential locations for public art opportunities.
