DESCRIPTION

The artistic concept began with connecting the interior to the sky. The design originated from the theme of clouds, and was influenced by information gathered from community engagement. The artwork draws on West African patterns and symbols as a universal language that exists beyond cultural and ethnic divides. Drawings on these fabric artworks are hand-made, scanned, then enlarged and heat-transfer on to the material.
